Even though it was officially removed from the US Highway System in 1985, the Mother Road lived on. Portions of the road have been designated a National Scenic Byway of the name "Historic Route 66". Driving it is much more fun than speeding on a modern highway system. Americans, and visitors from outside the country, take Route 66 and have the time of their life there. It is like going back in time or a sentimental journey, as on the way you can see numerous old motels, gas stations, shops, old cars or wagons. *
